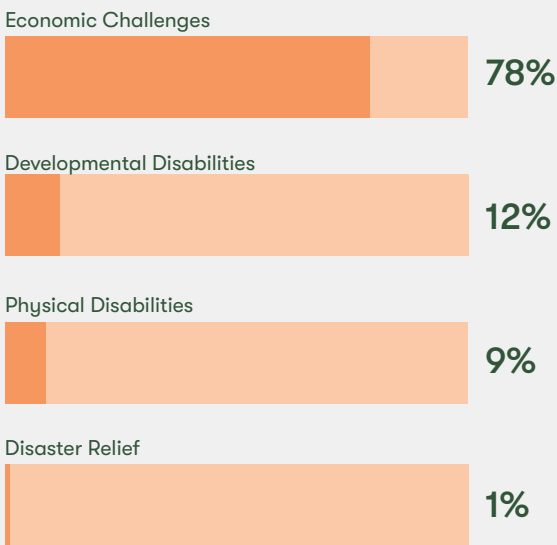

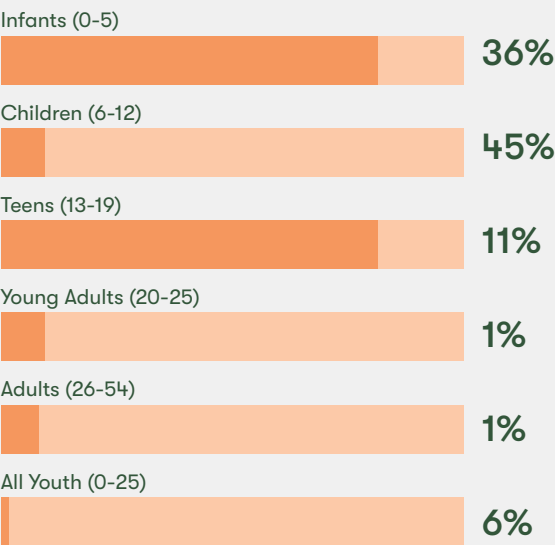

AGE GROUPS

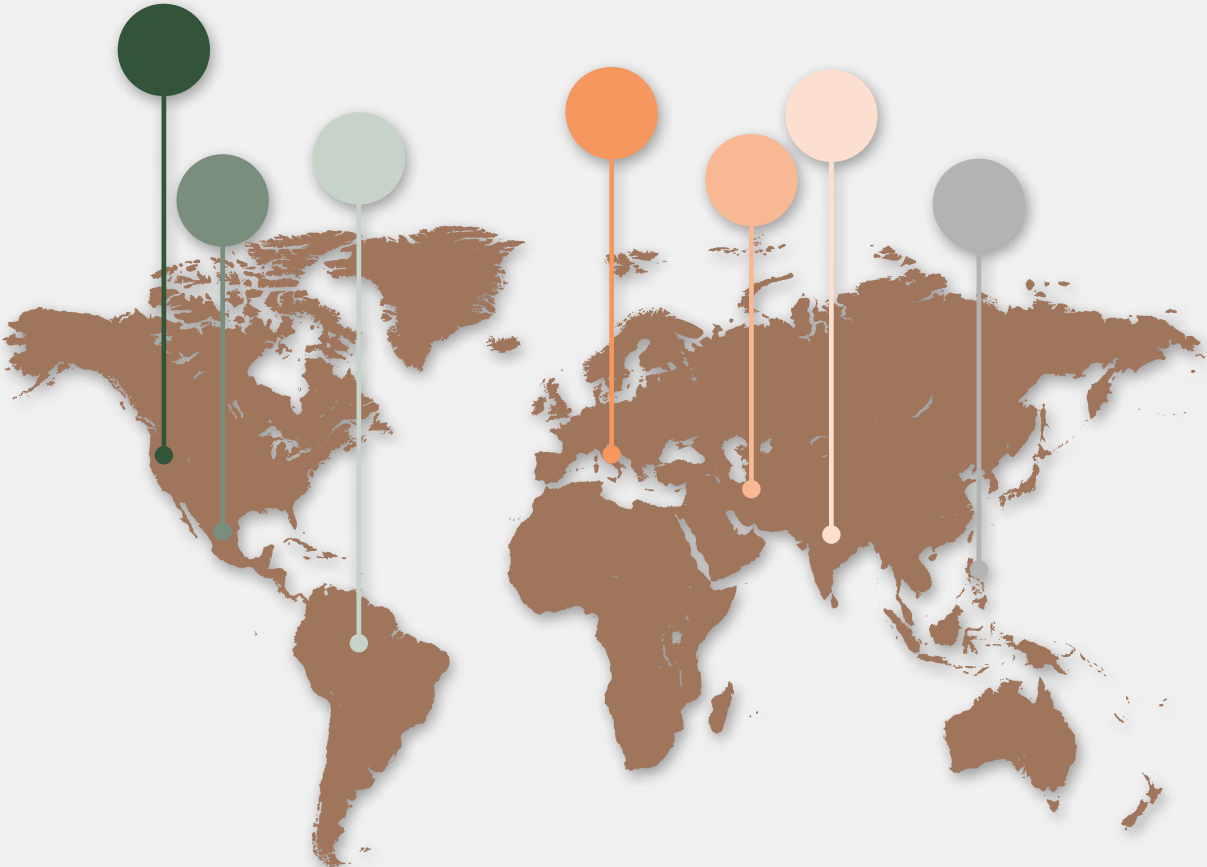

Casa Partner Spotlight: Acres of Love

South Africa

“In South Africa, infants who are abandoned are often already at crisis levels, leaving them vulnerable to malnutrition and its long-term effects. When they arrive at Acres of Love, our first priority is to restore their health through proper nutrition. Through the support of Herbalife Family Foundation, Acres of Love is able to provide every infant in its care with specialized medical-grade formula, ensuring that vulnerable children receive the nutrition they need to heal, grow, and flourish.

For more than 20 years, the Herbalife Family Foundation partnership has been instrumental in supporting the long-term health of the children at Acres of Love. In 2025, the partnership helped fund 76,800 meals for our families. This support impacted our children and our moms, providing healthy meals to combat past malnutrition and enabling our kids to succeed, from the classroom to university. This past year, we didn’t just provide nutritious meals for our children, we empowered them through cooking classes. As a result, our teens and young adults can prepare healthy meals on their own, helping them build lifelong healthy habits.

The story of ‘Qhawe,’ whose name has been changed for privacy purposes, illustrates the transformative power of this support.

Qhawe came to our family as a baby. Doctors told us that, due to his cerebral palsy, he might never walk or talk or even manage being in a classroom. He is now a preteen and has received incredible love, therapies and the very best nutritional care since the day he arrived. Today, Qhawe has risen above the odds. Not only can he walk with the assistance of a walking frame, but he can speak. He attends a specialized school for children with medical needs, where he thrives. He is popular and loved by his teachers and peers. He has an amazing sense of humor and can even kick a soccer ball around with his brothers on the lawn.”

Casa Partner Spotlight: Wilkinson Center

United States

“For more than a decade, the Herbalife Family Foundation and Wilkinson Center have worked side-by-side to ensure that no child in Dallas has to choose between hunger and opportunity. Since 2013, through the Casa Herbalife Program, Herbalife Family Foundation has invested more than \$450,000 in Wilkinson Center’s nutrition programs, helping thousands of children and families access healthy food, nutrition education, and the support they need to build brighter futures.

But the true impact of this partnership cannot be measured in dollars alone. It is measured in children arriving at school ready to learn, parents who no longer have to skip meals so their children can eat, and families who discover that food assistance can become the first step toward long-term stability.

That commitment was on full display on July 24, 2025, when Herbalife employees, Distributors, and leadership joined Wilkinson Center for a Back-to-School Backpack Giveaway and Grant Presentation. Together, volunteers distributed backpacks and school supplies to 100 children across Dallas, helping students begin the school year prepared and confident.

During the celebration, Herbalife Family Foundation also presented Wilkinson Center with a \$50,000 grant to support nutrition programming, including the Pantry2Go mobile food pantry. This investment continues to expand access to nutritious food for children and families living in some of Dallas County’s most food-insecure neighborhoods.

Herbalife’s impact extends beyond financial support. By volunteering alongside Wilkinson Center staff, Herbalife employees and Distributors demonstrate that meaningful partnerships are built through relationships just as much as resources. Their presence sends a powerful message to families that their community believes in them and is invested in their future.

After more than 12 years of partnership, Herbalife Family Foundation continues to help Wilkinson Center fulfill a simple but powerful promise: **every child deserves access to nutritious food, every family deserves hope, and every person deserves the opportunity to build a brighter future.**

Corporate Social Responsibility Spotlight: American Red Cross



“Every two seconds, someone in the U.S. needs blood. To help meet this constant demand, the American Red Cross collects and distributes approximately 40 percent of the nation’s blood supply, providing lifesaving blood products to patients facing cancer, traumatic injuries, chronic illnesses, and other medical emergencies. Behind every donation is an individual donor who has stepped forward to help save a life.

For 30 years, Herbalife has stood alongside the American Red Cross as a committed humanitarian partner helping strengthen communities during disaster relief, providing blood donation support, and engaging Herbalife employees in the lifesaving mission of the Red Cross. In 2025, our partnership reached a significant milestone as Herbalife celebrated 10 years as a national Blood Saves Lives partner and elevated its commitment to become a \$1 million in-kind partner, supporting Red Cross blood donors across the United States. Over the past

decade, these snacks have become part of the Red Cross donor experience, helping nourish individuals who take time out of their day to make a lifesaving contribution.

The partnership between the Red Cross and Herbalife extends beyond in-kind product donations. For more than two decades, Herbalife employees and Distributors have actively engaged in the Red Cross mission by hosting blood drives across the U.S. Since 2004, Herbalife has hosted more than 100 blood drives at company facilities and events, resulting in more than 3,900 units of blood donated and the recruitment of more than 1,200 first-time blood donors. Every donation has helped provide patients and families in urgent need with hope.

Herbalife has also demonstrated its commitment during devastating disasters. Through the support of employees, and Distributors, nearly \$280,000 has been contributed to the Red Cross to help people impacted by disasters like hurricanes and wildfires. The financial support and in-kind product donations have helped communities begin the difficult journey of recovery after a disaster.

“Herbalife’s longstanding support reflects the powerful role philanthropic partners can play in strengthening communities,” said Anne McKeough, chief development officer at the American Red Cross. “We are deeply grateful for their continued partnership and the meaningful impact they make in the lives of people across the country.”
